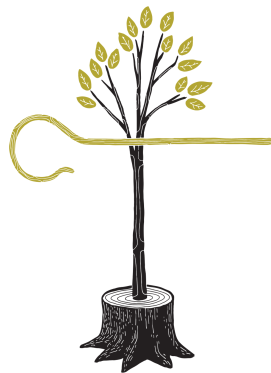

ABOUT THE STATIONS

(from the Latin, "statum" or, standing still)

"*The Stations of the Cross*" is one of the oldest Christian practices dating to the earliest centuries following Christ's death. Pilgrims would reflectively retrace the steps of Jesus leading to the cross. After visiting Jerusalem, pilgrims adapted the *Stations* to their own towns and times. Because crucifixions were public events (often taking place along highways or in ancient parking lots), the *Stations* have been adapted as you experience them today. Come reflect as modern pilgrims.

DIRECTIONS

1. STOP AT FIRST STATION
2. EXAMINE THE ARTWORK
3. PLAY AUDIO
4. OPTIONAL RESPONSE (*see below*)
5. CONTINUE TO NEXT STATION
