## MORE ABOUT TEEN REACH

Teen Reach is an innovative program that offers two three-day, summer camps (separated by biological sex) for teens in foster care, who have been abused, neglected, and abandoned. We work in cooperation with the Department of Social and Health Services, as well as local foster care agencies and Angel Tree to provide a camp that makes an impact in the lives of these teens.

Teen Reach Adventure Camp provides a unique ratio of at least one counselor to every two campers, providing an opportunity for the development of a strong connection between the counselors and their campers. While at camp, the campers are challenged to work together with their counselors and other campers in challenge course activities, which are comprised of team-building and trust building initiatives. These experiences help the teens learn the importance of **self-respect, respecting others, and learning to work together** while having fun.

T.R.A.C.life is a year-round mentoring program that was developed as an extension of Teen Reach Adventure Camps. Adolescence is such a difficult time in the lives of any child, but especially for those in foster care, as the chance of them getting adopted decreases each year. Accordingly, T.R.A.C.life was developed to help begin to teach the teens life skills and, more importantly, to have someone positive in their life that can provide them the support, stability, and encouragement they so desperately need.
