Luke 19:1-10

Jesus told a parable about two men who needed to build a house. The two men looked for the perfect place.

The first man loved the beach and chose to build his house on sand. It was easy to dig. He thought it was a great idea.

The second man was very wise. He also loved the beach, but he knew sand would not make a good foundation. The wise man chose to build his house on a rocky hill. It was hard work to dig and took a long time, but he knew his house would be safe on the rock.

One day, there was a huge storm. The rain poured down and the winds blew with all their strength. Soon the land became flooded. The storm swept away the house on the sand. But the house on the rock was safe.

When Jesus finished His parable, He taught what it really meant. Jesus said, "If you listen to my words and obey them. You are like the wise man. No matter which storms may come, you will be safe and secure."

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WELCOME

Prepare tables with the opening activities. Greet kids by name as kids arrive. Be sure to welcome any new families.

INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

Play a game of wise or foolish choices. Show preschoolers the prepared cards, reading the words out loud. Ask preschoolers to stand up if it's a wise choice - doing something which makes God glad; or sit down if it's a foolish choice - doing something which makes God sad.

Display the key passage poster. Read the words and help preshoolers memorize the words. Clap out a simple rhythm or pass a small object around the circle as each word is stated.

- Allow interested preshoolers to play with the Kinetic sand in the available bins.
