

## **NOAH AND THE ARK**



#### Genesis 6 - 9

### **PRESCHOOL**



#### **WELCOME**

Prepare tables with the opening activities. Greet kids by name as kids arrive. Be sure to welcome any new families.

TABLE #1 - Coloring sheet, draw with chalk TABLE #2 - golf tees, toy hammers, small cardboard box Floor - blocks, animal figures (see activities), tool kits



#### **INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY**

**Dove and the Branch -** Show preschoolers the olive branch. Tell preschoolers you will hide the olive branch for them to find. Have preschoolers close their eyes and hide the branch where they will not be able to find it. Have preschoolers pretend to be doves. Demonstrate how to use their arms to 'flap their wings', make a cooing sound with their voice, and move gently about the room looking for the olive branch. Gather preschoolers to the story circle and show them where the branch is located. Play again, but hide the branch where they can locate the branch. Remind preschoolers how the dove flew from the ark two times before finding an olive branch.

# **ACTIVITIES**



- Pass out two dove shapes to interested preschoolers. Allow them to add features and a bit of color. Attach the dove pieces to the stick and bend wings slightly. Demonstrate how to move the dove up and down so the wings flap.
- Noah sent a dove out of the ark to help him know if it was safe to exit the ark.
   When the dove did not return, he knew the dove had found a place to build a
   nest. When Noah and his family left the ark, Noah thanked God for keeping him
   and his family safe. God caused a rainbow to appear in the sky to remind Noah
   He would never flood the entire earth again. The rainbow reminds us God always
   keeps His promises.

- Use this activity at the beginning of class, if desired. Before class, add the chalk to the waterproof container and fill with water just enough to cover the chalk.
- Hand interested preschoolers a sheet of dark construction paper. Remove the chalk from the water and place near the coloring area at the table. Allow preschoolers to create colorful pictures with the wet chalk.
- Wet chalk makes the colors so much brighter! They're so pretty. I'm glad God created the rainbow to remind us of His promise to never flood the whole earth again. God is our Creator and King. We can trust Him to keep His promises.
