



A CHANGED MAN



Acts 9:1-19

Saul did not like Jesus' followers. He was on his way to put some of them in jail.

Suddenly, a bright light flared around him. Saul fell to the ground. A loud voice asked, "Saul, why are you against me?" Saul was afraid. He cried out, "Who are you?" The voice replied, "I am Jesus, the one you are against."

"Go to Damascus and you will be told what to do." When Saul got up, he could not see. Some men who were traveling with Saul led him to the city.

Jesus had also appeared to a man named Ananias. Jesus led Ananias to Saul. Ananias laid his hands on Saul and said, "Jesus sent me to you. You may see again. Be filled with the Holy Spirit." Immediately Saul could see! Then Ananias baptized him.

ACTIVITIES

CHANGE HEARTS

- Hand interested preschoolers a prepared heart. Allow them to decorate with stickers, crayons, or markers.
- Use the time to ask preschoolers about the story or review the key passage.
- **We will learn [or learned] about a man who had a changed heart. Saul was changed when Jesus appeared to him at the road to Damascus. What happened to Saul's eyes? Who helped Saul when he arrived in Damascus? Jesus met Saul and changed his heart. Jesus can change our hearts, too!**

BLIND WALK GAME

- Divide preschoolers into two or three per group and have one preschooler close their eyes (or if they are willing use the scarves to blindfold them).
- Have preschoolers take turns leading each other around the room at a slow, walking pace.
- **When Jesus appeared to Saul, he could not see after the bright light flashed around him. He had to be led by the men who were traveling with him to Damascus. Then Jesus told Ananias to help Saul see again and be baptized. After Saul met Jesus, he began telling people about Jesus.**
