

WELCOME

INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

WAITING GAME – Have preschoolers sit in a circle in the large group area. Explain when you say "go", they should wait for 5 to 10 seconds (which ever number you choose) before standing up. The person closest to the correct time wins. Start off with low numbers. Then build to higher ones – counting out loud will help younger preschoolers. **Today, we will learn about a time Jesus' friends were praying and waiting for a special helper. It was important they wait for God's perfect time. Sometimes we may have to wait for God's perfect timing before something happens.**

MAKE A PINWHEEL

- Handout a pinwheel paper to interested preschoolers. Encourage preschoolers to decorate their paper. Write their names on the back.
- Help preschoolers to assemble the pinwheel and placing the completed structure onto their choice of a colored stick.

HELLO

- Help preschoolers learn the word 'Hello' in other languages. Tell preschoolers you will say the word for hello in Spanish (Hola [O La]. Then they should repeat it after you.
- Here is a list of potential languages you can use: Setswana [Dumela]; Basque [Kaixo = Kie (like pie) Sho]; France [bon jour]; Japanese [konnichiwa]; Hawaiian [aloha]; Italian [ciao (chow); Hebrew [shalom]
