Acts 16:24 - 34

INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

HEART EXCHANGE RELAY Create a dividing line with the painter's tape in the middle of the story area. Divide the preschoolers into teams and line them up one behind the other. Have the first preschooler in each line run and grab a heart from the basket at the opposite side of the space. They must race back and place their heart on the MATCHING HEART secured to the their teams table. We will learn about how God helped Paul and Silas show love to the guard of the prison they were in. Let's listen to what happened.
