PRESCHOOL



WELCOME

Prepare tables with the opening activities. Greet kids by name as kids arrive. Be sure to welcome any new families.

INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

Have preschoolers tidy of the room and then gather in the story area. Lead preschoolers in the song “Head, Shoulder, Knees & Toes” while performing the hand motions (note attached lyric sheet). Repeat as time allows, speeding up the song until all silliness breaks out and there is lots of giggling.
