BIRTHDAY PARTY FOR JESUS DECORATE THE TREE RELAY

Goal: Be the first team to successfully have all their decorations hanging on the tree.

- Separate K-2nd graders into 3 teams. Each team will choose someone to be the "tree."
- The team, and decorating supplies at one end of room, while the "tree" stands across from their team at the other end.
- When time starts, first team member in line takes a piece of decoration (garland, stars, etc) from the bin and runs to tree, hangs on tree, runs back. Next person does the same, and so on.
- If, after using all your decorations, some have fallen off, the next person in line must go and rehang ONE of the things that has fallen. Repeat until everything is hung.

OPTION for a 2nd round if 1st round goes quickly: Remove all decorations from original "tree." Small group leader now becomes the "tree." When time starts, team members all gather around their tree (not relay style) and work together to decorate their leader the best they can. Winner will be decided by Judge Steve.
