Genesis 1:1-13

In the beginning God made heaven and earth. At first it was empty and dark. but God gathered up the light and called it day. Then He gathered up the darkness and called it night. God was watching over everything.

PRESCHOOL



WELCOME

Prepare tables with the opening activities. Greet kids by name as kids arrive. Be sure to welcome any new families.

INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

Have preschoolers tidy of the room and then gather in the story area where you have placed a piece of painter's tape on the floor to designate between the *LAND AND SEA*. You may decide if you want to use the pictures provided to help preschoolers remember which side of the tape is Land and which side is the Sea. Explain to preschoolers you will call out which area they are to be in and the movement associated with each side. When you call out "LAND" preschoolers should be jumping on the land portion of the floor; when you call out "SEA" preschoolers should mimic swimming in the sea portion with their arms. Keep calling out Land or Sea at different intervals of time (fast or slow); or call out the same space 2x in a row. Continue playing until you are ready to begin the story for today.

That was a fun game! It reminds me about what we will hear from God's word - God is the Creator of all things. We will learn about the first three days of creation today. See if you can remember the day God made the land and sea.

- Allow interested preschoolers to play with the kinetic sand. New things will be added each week for this month to help preschoolers remember the days of creation.
