Psalm 139:14-16

Hey everyone I'm Bailey and I love to draw. I love it so much I even drew a picture of me drawing a picture. Some people can sing pretty songs. Some people can tell amazing stories and some can draw pictures. I'm glad God made all of us special. I like to draw because I love God and He made our whole world. Drawing is one way I show His love.

The Bible tells about a person who showed love to God through songs and poems. His name was David and he wrote a lot of song poems for God called Psalms. They're in the Bible.

In one of his poems, he praises God because God knows everything and everyone. He wrote, "God you have seen everything about me and you know me. You know me when I'm sitting down and when I go somewhere. You know everything I'm gonna say before I say it."

it's kind of like this: [narrator pauses and says 'peanut butter.'] God knew I was gonna say that before I even did. God knows you better than your parents know you!

David wrote that God is everywhere all at once from the highest sky to the deepest ocean. He already knew you and loved you before you were ever born. He knew what you would look like, sound like, and even what you'd like to eat. Nothing about you is a mistake. God made you just the way you are supposed to be.

David wrote to God, "I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made." That means God made you special. Because David loved God so much, he ended the song poem by asking God to help him fix any part of him that is not following God's way and doing the right thing.

Remember, God made you on purpose for a purpose. God knows you and loves you more than anything else and He made you so you could be with Him forever.

WELCOME

Prepare tables with the opening activities. Greet kids by name as kids arrive. Be sure to welcome any new families.

INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

Have preschoolers tidy up the room and join you in the large group area.
WONDERFULLY MADE – Call out body parts while children touch them. Examples: Touch your head. **Wiggle your fingers.** Blink your eyes. **Jump with your legs.** Listen with your ears. **Smell with your nose.** After each one say: "God made my ____!" [fingers, legs, etc].
We are going to hear how God made each of us on purpose for a purpose.
